

MRS. ERVIN ALLEN PASSES

Funeral Monday at Station Cemetery
Near Walnut

Mrs. Ervin Allen, age 40, who lived between Marshall and Walnut, died at her home Sunday, August 10, about 11 o'clock A. M. She had been in poor health for about a year and died from a leakage of the heart. Funeral services were held at the Station cemetery Monday afternoon at two o'clock, conducted by Rev. B. E. Guthrie. Mrs. Allen leaves six children. Her husband, who was a Confederate veteran, died about three years ago. His sons, Jim and Ben Allen, came to see her but arrived after her death. Mrs. Allen's own children are as follows: Mrs. Emmett Davis, Wiley Allen, and Miss Kathleen Allen, Sherman, Frank and Houston. The last three are from eight years up. Jim Allen will take the two youngest to live with him in Kentucky. He was in Marshall this Tuesday morning. The deceased Mrs. Allen leaves one sister, who lives at Elizabethton, Tenn.
