

FRANK AMMONS DIED SATURDAY.

Frank Ammons died in Wallace Thomsom hospital at 3:30 o'clock Saturday afternoon and was buried in the Gallman graveyard near Bethlehem church.

Mr. Ammons was stricken with appendicitis and brought last week to the hospital. The operation was performed, but from the first the odds were against him, the disease having progressed too far.

He was 30 years of age, and was born in Marshall, N. C. He was a resident of Union county for the past 16 years. He married Miss Belle Gallman in 1912, and is survived by his wife and three children, and by his father, W. E. Ammons, and one sister, Miss Julia Ammons and three brothers, J. C., Fred and George Ammons.
