

# GUY D. BUCKNER BURIED NEAR MARS HILL

**Body With Bullet Hole In Head  
Found At Madison Home**

Funeral service for Guy D. Buckner, well known farmer of the Ivy section, Madison county, who was found shot to death at his home about 8:30 o'clock Sunday night, was conducted at the home Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment was in the cemetery at the Forks of Ivy.

The body of Mr. Buckner was found by his wife shortly after he had gone into a room at the back of the house after supper. Mrs. Buckner later said she heard a shot and went to investigate. The bullet entered just above the right ear and came out over the left ear.

Mr. Buckner was said to be in financial difficulties. In addition to his farm, he had been conducting a loan and insurance business in Mars Hill.

Madison county officers, who investigated, said an inquest was unnecessary.

Mr. Buckner is survived by his widow; two sons, Garth and Bruce; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. D. C. Buckner, of Mars Hill; a sister, Mrs. James Ramsey, Jr., of Mars Hill; and five brothers, Jamie, Robert and Perry Buckner, of Mars Hill, and Lewis and Emmons Buckner, of Virginia. 7/27/33
