

Mrs. Harriet Buckner, age 97, of Little Pine, died at her home Sunday, May 6, at 11 A.M., paralysis being given as the cause of her death. Funeral services were from the Kirk Payne cemetery at 11 o'clock Monday morning, conducted by the Rev. Mr. Roberson. Mrs. Buckner was remarkably active for her age and was practically well until Friday before her death, when she became unusually sleepy and remained in a stupor until the end. She was the last of 26 brothers and sisters, half and whole. Her husband died six years ago. She is survived by the following sons and daughters: Mrs. Emily Bryan, Mrs. Annie Goforth, and Mr. Henry C. Buckner, of Little Pine.
