

## JAMES R. DEAVER DEAD

Passed Away at His Home in  
Seattle, Washington

Sergeant-Major James R. Deaver, a former resident of Madison died at his home in Seattle, Washington, Sunday, April 5. He held high rank in military circles and a military funeral was held in Seattle before the body was shipped. The body is expected to arrive in Marshall Sunday April 19, on No. 12 and the funeral and interment will be Monday at about 2:00 o'clock P. M.

Interment will be in the Roberts cemetery near Marshall. Mr. Deaver was an uncle of Mr. S. B. Roberts, Mr. J. Will Roberts, Dr. Frank Roberts, and Mr. O. W. Deaver of Marshall. He is survived by two brothers, Mr. W. T. S. Deaver of Russellville, Tenn.; Mr. E. V. Deaver of Marshall and one sister, Mrs. Hattie Briggs of Chattanooga, Tenn.

He leaves two sons, one about seventeen in Seattle, and Mr. Oscar Deaver of the Petersburg section of Madison County, who is quite a successful business man.

The deceased was about 66 years of age and is said to have accumulated considerable wealth. He left Madison County about 40 years ago and was a Marine in the United States Navy, but had retired as a military officer some ten years ago.
