

Died on Train After an Accident Yesterday

Following injuries received yesterday afternoon at the plant of the Shale Brick Company of Shaleville, near Hot Springs, S. J. Garland, superintendent of the plant, died soon after being placed on a train to be brought to Asheville for medical attention. The body was removed at Hot Springs and sent to Knoxville, a former home of the deceased, where funeral services will be held.

Mr. Garland was building an arch at the time of the accident, when, for some cause, it fell, burying him under the ruins. The deceased is survived by his widow and two sons. — Asheville Times. (NR) 3/23/17
