

CLEMIT GRAVES HENDERSON DEAD

Mr. Clemit G. Henderson, proprietor of the Henderson Motor Co. died at a hospital in Asheville last Saturday, August 7, at about three o'clock in the mornnig. The cause of his death was given as a leaking heart. He had been in failing health for several months but was seriously ill about seven weeks. Funeral services were Sunday afternoon at three o'clock conducted by Rev. B. E. Guthrie and Rev. Nehemiah Griffin, interment following in the Henderson family burying ground about 2 1-2 miles from Marshall. Mr. Henderson was 35 years old and was the proprietor of the Henderson Motor Co. and the Pastime Theatre. At his request the following acted as pallbearers: Boyd Ramsey, Hugh Fisher, Marvin Silvers, Millard Hensley, Loy Sprinkle, Wiley Sprinkle, G. H. Rector, Paul Hensley.

Mr. Henderson is survived by his wife and three children, Otto, Winford and Plato Henderson. He is also survived by his mother, Mrs. Hester Anne Henderson, three brothers, Mr. Reagan Henderson and Mr. Mack Henderson of Washington, D. C., and Mr. J. C. Henderson, of Marshall; and one sister, Mrs. Claud Rector of Madison County. An immense crowd of people attended the funeral.
