

M. L. GUDGER DEAD

Mr. Mont Love Gudger died Tuesday about 3 o'clock in the afternoon at his home at Barnard. Mr. Gudger was 65 years old and had been afflicted several years. Especially since the first of the year had he been in poor health following a case of influenza.
