

Death of Little Taska Ramsey.

Last Saturday evening between seven and eight o'clock and while the family were out of the house, Faska, the two and a half year old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Jerry Ramsey, of Walnut Springs, got hold of the oil can and it was presumed that the child was pouring the oil on the fire which had almost gone out, when it suddenly ignited catching the clothing of the child on fire. The mother hearing the cries of the child ran into the house and quickly extinguished the flames, but not until one side of the child had been badly burned, medical attention was immediately given and everything that could be done was done but the little one was so badly burned that on Monday night at about nine o'clock the spirit of the little one departed. Services were conducted by Rev. S. T. Hensley and interment was at the family burying ground on the hill above the home of the bereaved parents, Tuesday evening at 8:30.
