

Charles Cassada Shoots and
Kills Garland Teague.

On last Saturday evening Chas. Cassada, Sandy Mush, shot and killed Garland Teague of the same section. We have been informed that the difficulty arose over some colts that were feeding on Cassada's pasture. The colts belonged to the Teague people. The shot took effect in Teagues heart and he died almost instantly. He was buried on Tuesday.

Sheriff Buckner was called to the scene on Tuesday and Cassada gave up, came to Marshall and made bond for his appearance for trial at the March Term of the Superior Court.

Mr. Cassada is well known in the county, having served one or two terms on the board of County Commissioners.

Garland Teague is a son of Mr. Gold Teague, a well known citizen of the county. Both the Cassada and Teague families are influential people in their section of the county. The facts have been reported to us in two or three different ways and if the evidence shall be in court as it comes to us it will be a case for the jury.

We therefore refrain from expressing any opinion, one way or the other, and from narrating the facts as reported. We have no desire to prejudice the rights of either state or defendant or to influence with a narrative of uncertain facts, the minds of probable jurors.

We regret to hear of this untimely trouble between our people. It is a sad affair for all parties connected with the event and we sympathize with the people both families in this tragedy of death.
