

Death of Edward Tipton

Mr. Edward Tipton, aged 72 years died at the home of his son, James Tipton, of Marshall on March 10th, 1919. He was buried at the Roberts Graveyard near Marshall on March 11th. Rev. Woodson of the Free Will Baptist church conducted the service. Mr. Tipton was one of Marshall's oldest residents and in past years had been identified with the town's development in many ways, having served as police of the town for several years.
