

B. F. Worley Dies At Home of Son in Canto

Benjamin Franklin Worley, aged 69, died at his son's home in Canto, Madison County, last Sunday evening, November 25. Mr. Worley was an old confederate veteran, having been with Lee's army at the time of the surrender at Appomattox. He was a member of the Baptist Church, and had served as a deacon for forty years. Funeral services were held on Tuesday, the Rev. T. D. Ganning officiating. Pallbearers were: Lee Suttle, H. E. Carver, J. F. Randall, J. F. Black, E. G. Ball, and E. G. Meadows.

The deceased is survived by a brothers W. C. Worley, of Leicester; a sister, living in Alaska; a son, M. B. Worley, and two daughters, Mrs. J. M. Mill, and Miss E. E. Worley, all of Canto.—Asheville Citizen.
